

WATER QUALITY

The district will comply with regulations set forth by the Environmental Protection Agency's Safe Drinking Water Act and Lead Contamination Control Act.

District drinking water lead levels shall not exceed maximum contaminant levels for lead contaminations as established in the National Drinking Water Standard, by the Environmental Protection Agency.

The board will establish a water quality sampling program whereby samples of drinking water at each school shall be collected and analyzed for lead to verify compliance to drinking water regulations. The drinking water sampling program will follow recommendations set forth by the Washington State Department of Health and Environmental Protection Agency.
