Monetary Contribution

The board recognizes that individual and organizations in the community may wish to contribute additional supplies or equipment to enhance and extend the instructional program an individual or an organization desiring to make a monetary contribution, will meet with school officials regarding the intended use of the contribution in advance of making the contribution.

All contributions will be recorded on forms designated by the Superintendent or designee and will state the amount and intended purpose. A monetary contribution equal to or less than \$1,000.00 may be accepted by the Superintendent, or designee.

Additionally, any gift or donation to the district or to an individual school or department of money, materials or equipment having a value of \$1,000 or greater will be presented to the Superintendent's office for Board consideration and approval. All monetary contributions will be deposited as District revenues and spent using established purchasing procedures.
